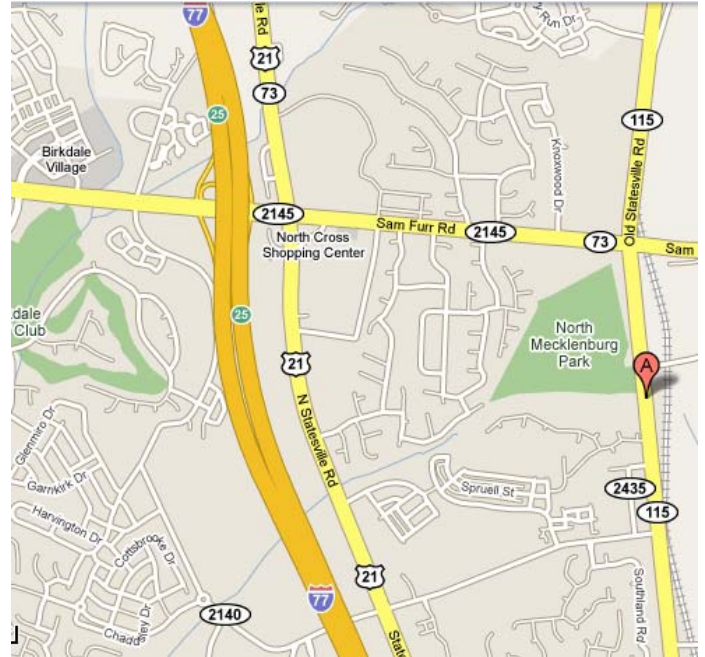
Directions to N. Mecklenburg Park Huntersville, NC
